Inclement Weather Planning 2022-2023

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Dear JCSC Parents/Guardians,

Thank you for all of your support for our students and schools this school year! It has been wonderful to see high attendance rates at school activities and events, such as Homecoming, Veterans Day, and other special events. We appreciate your support and involvement. You are vital to our work of encouraging student opportunities and success!

As we begin to prepare for possible inclement weather this winter, we would like to share some updates and planning information. This year, the Indiana Department of Education has limited school districts to three days where we may use eLearning days (teachers post assignments online and students work at their own pace at home). In addition to the three eLearning days, schools are allowed to use traditional make up days and/or live virtual learning. Live virtual learning days are days where students log in to Google Meets for classroom instruction. Schools are required to provide live teacher led instruction on these days.

Jennings County School Corporation will utilize a schedule to plan which types of days will be used if school instruction must change due to inclement weather (snow days). We would like to share that schedule with our families, so they may also be prepared in the event of the need to change instruction due to poor road conditions or snow.

Day 1 (First Snow Day)	No School; This day will be a regular make-up day on Presidents' Day Feb. 20 th
Day 2 (Second Snow Day)	eLearning Day (Students work online at their own pace, no live instruction)
Day 3	eLearning Day (Students work online at their own pace, no live instruction)

Day 4	eLearning Day (Students work online at their own pace, no live instruction)
Day 5	No School; This will be a regular make-up day on Thursday, May 25 th
Day 6 and beyond	Virtual Learning Day (Students will have live online learning. Students must login to class times for live lessons on Google Meet with teacher online.)

Additional Information:

- **eLearning Days**- Students work on assignments at their own pace from home. There will be no live teacher instruction log in times required. Student attendance is counted based upon work completion, Google Classroom login, and teacher communication. Teachers are available for communication and support throughout the day (8:30am-3:00pm).
- **Live Virtual Learning Days**- Students must log in to Google Meets for live instruction.

Elementary students: 9:00am-11:30am

JCMS: 8:30am-1:00pm (Lunch is 11:05-12:00)

JCHS: 8:30am-12:45pm (Lunch is 11:05-12:00)

Students will work on independent assignments after live instruction. Student attendance is counted based upon Google Meet attendance, assignment completion, and communication with school staff. Teachers are available throughout the day for support and instruction (8:30am-3:00pm).

Our schools have been planning and practicing these options with our students. You will receive additional information from your child's school or teacher. If you need internet connection support, we do have hotspots available for our students. Please reach out to your child's school for hotspot requests or any questions regarding planning.
