

VOLUNTEER RELEASE FORM

I agree to abide by all relevant School Board policies and administrative guidelines while on duty for the Corporation. I understand that, although I am covered under the Corporation's liability insurance policy, I am not covered by its health insurance policy nor am I eligible for workers' compensation. Should I become ill or suffer an accident while doing volunteer work for the Corporation, I agree that I shall be responsible for any and all hospital and medical charges that may accrue.

I understand further that, as a volunteer, I am not in any manner considered an employee of the Corporation or entitled to any benefits provided to employees. I further release the Board from any and all liability for any damages, whatever their nature, which may result as a consequence of my volunteer services.

I understand that I am required to report to the Superintendent within two (2) business days any arrests, the filing of criminal charges against me, and any conviction for a crime that occur while I am serving as a volunteer.

I understand that I am required to report to the Superintendent within two (2) business days any substantiated report of child abuse or neglect of which I am the subject that occurs while I am serving as a volunteer.

I understand that the Corporation must conduct a criminal background check for the protection of the children in its schools. I agree:

to submit a Limited Criminal History Record Check for supervised volunteers.

to submit to an Expanded Criminal History Check for unsupervised volunteers which shall include:

- A. national criminal history check (as defined by I.C. 20-26-2-1.5) of the criminal history record system maintained by the Federal Bureau of Investigation based on fingerprint identification or another method of positive identification;
- B. an expanded child protection index check as defined by I.C. 20-26-2-1.3;
- C. search of the national sex offender registry maintained by the United States Department of Justice;
- D. beginning July 1, 2017, a search of the State child abuse registry;
- E. an Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles driver history if the position involves driving.

For the protection of the children in the school, the Corporation is required by law to inquire of its staff members whether or not they have ever been convicted of a crime related to children.

I affirm, under the penalties for perjury, that I have never been convicted of any of the following offenses: aggravated murder, murder, voluntary manslaughter, involuntary manslaughter, felonious assault, aggravated assault, assault, aggravated menacing, abuse or neglect of a child, kidnapping, abduction, child stealing, criminal child enticement, rape, sexual battery, corruption of a minor, gross sexual imposition, importuning, voyeurism, public indecency, felonious sexual penetration, compelling prostitution, promoting prostitution, procuring prostitution, disseminating matter harmful to juveniles, pandering obscenity, pandering obscenity involving a minor, pandering sexually-oriented matter involving a minor, illegal use of a minor in nudity-oriented material or performance, endangering children, contributing to the delinquency of children, carrying concealed weapons, improperly discharging a firearm at or into a school or house, corrupting another with drugs, placing harmful objects in or adulterating food or confection.
